WHAT IS A REPTILE?

The word "reptile" comes from the Latin word "reptilis," meaning "to crawl." Today, there are more than 10,000 recognized species of reptiles. This number changes as new species are discovered and others are reclassified. Reptiles are cold-blooded, meaning they cannot regulate their body temperature internally. They must rely on the sun to warm up and the shade to cool down. This is why they are often found in warm, sunny environments. They are also very adaptable, and many species have evolved unique survival strategies.

The four main orders of reptiles are crocodiles and alligators (Crocodylia), lizards and snakes (Squamata), turtles and tortoises (Testudines), and tuatara (Rhynchocephalia).



TUATARA (RHYNCHOCEPHALIA)

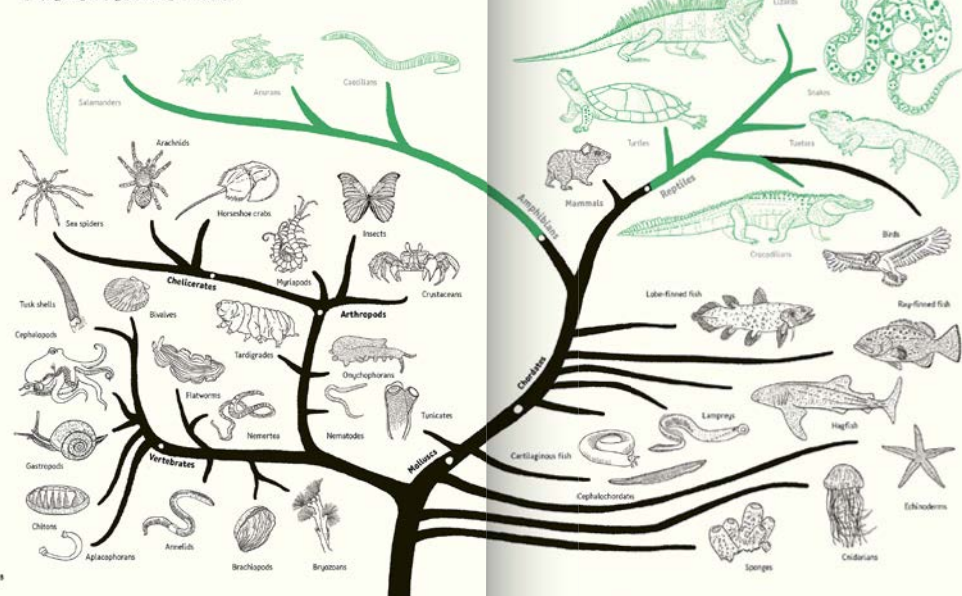
This species of reptile is only found in New Zealand and is the only living member of the order Rhynchocephalia. It is a small, lizard-like creature with a long, scaly tail. It is a cold-blooded animal and is a very primitive reptile. It is a very rare species and is considered a living fossil.

LIZARDS AND SNAKES (SQUAMATA)

Squamata are the most diverse reptiles, making up 90% of all reptiles. They are cold-blooded, meaning they cannot regulate their body temperature internally. They must rely on the sun to warm up and the shade to cool down. This is why they are often found in warm, sunny environments. They are also very adaptable, and many species have evolved unique survival strategies.
